

## **RDA Practical Exam Procedures to be Tested**

The RDA Practical Examination will require that you perform the following procedures. Additional information about materials and supplies is contained in the other examination materials sent to you.

Candidates will be allowed 1½ hours to complete the following two procedures. However, the entire examination process, including registration, grading, and clean-up, will take 4 to 5 hours.

### **1. Fabrication and Placement of a Temporary Crown**

Fabrication and placement of a temporary crown on tooth #8. Candidates may either bring an impression to the examination, or may take an impression(s) during their test time. No water will be available in the examination room, and no additional time will be given to candidates to make the impression during their 1½ hour test time.

Refer to the exam instructions concerning temporary crown materials which are NOT acceptable during the examination.

COMDA will provide the prepared tooth at the exam; candidates must present a typodont with a normal typodont tooth #8.

### **2. Placement of a Temporary Restoration**

Placement of a temporary restoration in tooth #19.

Candidates must present a typodont with a COMDA-approved prepared tooth inserted for tooth #19.
